#### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:**

One Year Scholarships of up to \$2,500 each will be awarded. Applicants will be judged on the basis of class standing, citizenship, leadership potential and financial need. A professional staff will coordinate the processing of all applications for approval by the Board of Trustees. The Scholarship Committee will review & recommend applications to the Board of Trustees for approval. #### TO QUALIFY for a 200 CLUB SCHOLARSHIP:

A parent must be actively serving Hudson County in a branch of public safety up to **December 31, 2022\***.

Diploma Requirements: The applicant must be a bona fide student of a private, parochial or public school located in New Jersey and must be eligible to receive a high school diploma by **June**, **2023**.

Aspirations: The applicant must have a definite plan to pursue a post-high school program of education or training on a full time basis.

Character: The applicant must have exhibited good citizenship traits and be of sound moral character.

The 200 Club of Hudson County is a non-profit organization formed in 1984 to provide financial assistance to the dependents of members of the Hudson County Police, Municipal Police, Firefighters, Emergency Medical Services and NJ State Police serving Hudson County who have lost their lives or were gravely injured in the line of duty.

The Scholarship Program was established in 1988 to aid children of actively serving public safety personnel in their desire to attend college, vocational school or to acquire other post-high school education.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Applicants will be limited to high school seniors who have a parent <u>actively</u> serving <u>Hudson County</u> as of December 31, 2022\* in one of the following branches of public safety: \*\*

Local Police & Law Enforcement NJ State Police Hudson County Sheriff NJ Transit Police Local Fire Department (including volunteer firefighters) Hudson County Prosecutor's Office Emergency Medical Services

\*\*Eligibility is limited to the children of public safety employees only in the branches reflected above. <u>It does not include children of personnel working in support staff, clerical or other non-related public safety duties.</u>
